


Webasto ChargeConnect Updates October 2023

New user interface for charging data

With the October update of the Webasto ChargeConnect, the charging data view in the Web Portal has been given a redesigned user interface. In addition to a simplified selection of the time period, the data can also be filtered according to selected charging stations or authorization tags.

Automatic sending of the charging data as a report via email

The charging data has not only been given a new look, but you can also enjoy a new add-on. In addition to the direct download as an Excel file, the charging data can now be sent automatically to a saved email address either monthly or quarterly. In addition, the report can be pre-filtered according to certain filters (charging station, authorization tag).
